  - j. Travel: John Skrabal- planning on setting up "Camp Wildcat" for the football game Friday (pizza) and the Millard Exhibition on Saturday (Raising Canes). Normally, we set up Camp Wildcat at each competition and the Boosters provide food, drinks and snacks for the students

in a fun atmosphere. We hope it has given the new students a feel for what competitions will be like.

- b. Open Exec Board positions for the next school year: VP of fundraising and 2 at large positions. Please talk to any board member if you are interested.
- 6. Director's Report: John Keith
  - a. It is cold this week and we will be outside every day. Please remind your students to dress appropriately for these temperatures.
  - b. Early rehearsal changes for Friday 10/23: 7am Varsity, 7:30am Mass Band pregame rehearsal
  - c. No early rehearsal Thursday 10/22 due to AWA testing and late start.
  - d. Football game Friday 10/23:
    - i. Itinerary will be sent out soon with exact times, but will run the same as the last game (Eat together, change into uniform, perform pregame, game starts at 7:30)
    - ii. JV performs at halftime
    - iii. Still need to present your Metro Performers pass for 6 tickets per performer. However, school activity passes will not cover the fee for this game since it is a playoff game.
    - iv. If MW wins this game, they will play Millard South at Buell as the visiting team. It's possible a small pep band will attend.
  - e. Millard Exhibition Performance: Saturday 10/24 performances beginning at 6pm
    - i. This is for both JV and Varsity Bands
    - ii. Itinerary will be sent soon, but looking at a mid afternoon arrival, a small lunch, change into uniforms, move frontline down to the track, then watch the other schools perform.
    - iii. Order of performances: MN JV, MW JV, MN, MW, MS.
    - iv. Return to MW following the performances to unload truck and check in uniforms.
    - v. Only 4 tickets per performer, due to large number of performers. Look for an email soon with a google form to rsvp.
  - f. End of Season Celebration will look different this year, but we are still planning on it happening. More details will be sent as soon as finalized with administration.
  - g. We move into concert season next week. Students received their audition music on Thursday via Google Classroom for band and chair placements (1st block is Wind Ensemble or Symphonic Band, 2nd Block is Concert Band). Auditions will be via video submissions next week. Percussion will have assigned in person times next week. Still talking to administration about concerts, and if we can have an audience or if they will be live streamed.
  - h. Jazz Band: info posted on google classroom for those interested. Have a lot of percussion and saxophones interested, but need more brass in order to have a full jazz band. Please encourage your student to sign up. Freshmen can participate in jazz band.
  - i. Winter Percussion Ensemble: hoping to get a group together.
  - j. Winter Guard: WGI (national group) cancelled season, HWAA (local group) might have events. We will still have a Winter Guard and auditions will be in early November.
  - k. Trailer update: going well and on track to make the downpayment in November. John will contact the company and confirm plans with the district. Still looking at additional pledges to ensure the full amount is covered.
  - I. Will discuss next year's budget with exec board to discuss any equipment that needs to be repaired, replaced or updated.
  - m. Congratulations to the students who made All State: Rachel Yang (flute 2nd year), Zoe Lindquist (oboe 3rd year), Allison Neuman (clarinet 1st year), Cam Berry (Bari Sax 1st year),

- Preston Ward (trombone 2nd year) and Jack Schula (percussion 1st year). They will need to submit a recording of their music for a high end virtual performance.
- n. A huge thank you to all of the parents who have helped this season. You have been awesome making sure we are ready to roll and looking good, from being at rehearsals, to building and fixing things, to fitting and refitting uniforms, and chaperoning at Camp Wildcat. We will be the only school in uniform at the Exhibition, as Millard North and Millard South did not issue uniforms this season. We wanted the students to be in the new uniforms this year for the experience and excitement.
- o. We made it through the first grading period, but cases are spiking again in the community. The students are being very good at school following the guidelines, but we need everyone at home and in the community to also follow the guidelines, wear your mask, and please avoid large gatherings. We all need to use good judgement and make good choices to keep the kids in school.
